**Subject: Important Update: Potential Delays in Child Care Subsidy Payments**

Dear Child Care Services (CCS) Provider,

Recently, there have been news reports about possible fraud in Minnesota's child care system. Because of these concerns, the news article says that the federal government, specifically the Administration for Children and Families (ACF), which manages the Child Care and Development Fund (CCDF), is changing how it sends money to states.

The news article says that all states will now have to provide extra proof and justification to the ACF *before* they will release CCDF funds, including "photo evidence". TWC has not yet received specific instructions from the federal government on what kind of "photo evidence" will be required.

What this means for you is that it will likely take longer for the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) to receive CCDF funds from the federal government. Because of this, payments to all CCS providers *could* be delayed. We don't yet know exactly how long the delays might be.

We are working with TWC to get access to CCDF funds as quickly as possible for the next payment cycle (January 12th - January 25th). Our goal is to minimize any impact this new federal requirement may cause.
